Didier Dietschi holds positions of adjunct professor at the University of CASE Western (Cleveland, USA) and senior lecturer at the University of Geneva (Switzerland). He is associate clinician at the Geneva Smile Center. Didier is recognised as being one of the world's leading exponents of Bio-aesthetics – redesigning smiles without unnecessary tissue sacrifice. This technique ensures optimal patient satisfaction and better long-term health. His lectures will expose you to innovative thinking and take you to new levels in restorative adhesive dentistry. Didier recently developed the MIRIS 2 composite system in collaboration with Coltène Whaledent, a technique which takes you a step closer to the ideal of creating 'artificial reality'.



Michel Magne

Michel Magne was born in la Chaux-de-Fonds in Switzerland in 1958. He was certified as a dental technician in 1979 and developed his technical education in fixed prosthodontics (ceramics) and aesthetics until 1984. Between 1985 and 1991, Michel consecutively directed two dental laboratories as master ceramist, specialising in implant-supported work and complex oral rehabilitation. Between 1992 and 2004, Michel was the owner and director of Oral Design Center Dental Laboratory in Montreux, Switzerland. Currently working in the United States, he is author and co-author of several articles on aesthetic dentistry and is frequently invited to lecture on these topics.
